Skyline National Bank Makes Donation to Plenty!

July 21, 2020 | Independence, VA – Skyline National Bank announces a \$2,000 donation to Plenty!, a nonprofit organization dedicated to being an ongoing source of healthy food for Floyd County.

Plenty! serves as the largest food pantry in Floyd County, having served 123 tons of food in 2019. In addition to the pantry, they also offer a Portable Produce delivery program, an organic community farm, and nutritional educational programs that target their two most vulnerable populations: children and the elderly. Plenty! is unique in the fact that they do not screen income, as they recognize needs often arise regardless of wages, and they provide bags of groceries as opposed to meals.

“We understand firsthand the toll that COVID-19 has taken on our neighbors, and we want to do whatever we can to help support them during this time.” said Devereux Jarratt local board member of Skyline National Bank.

Since the COVID-19 crisis began in March, visits to Plenty! have increased over 17%. Currently, they are serving over 150 families per week at the pantry, and an additional 60+ households without transportation through the Portable Produce delivery program (which began on June 17th of this year).
